Chairman's Report for 7th November 2018

Hot Water & Heating Boiler

Harry Denison has re-quoted and I have asked him to diary the work. This needs to be gain final approval at the November meeting. Harry will dovetail the work with the bookings diary. I have yet to find a local electrical engineer to modify the Heatmiser system.

PAT Tester & Testing

Tester calibrated and ready for the new year testing.

MRI

A MRI Scan is due. We need to set a date.

In the meantime I have asked Ron Goddard to clear out the gulley and also to cut the end of the hedge dividing the Sub Station from the Rectory Garden so that it doesn't overhang the footpath. It seems that the PC contractor is incapable of doing this!

Floors

I, and I'm sure some of you, have received many favourable comments on the floors from our users and the public. Some even think that we have replaced the entire floors!

External Lighting

Colin Silvester has replaced one of the Clock Tower floodlights which had failed and has re-set the timer for the Village Sign as the memory had been wiped!

Loft

All items that can go in bins have been sorted and stored in them. All bins have been labeled. I will produce a checklist to be kept in the loft and to be used as a control sheet.

Roman Blinds

I have removed one of the blinds to the loft for safe keeping as all the strings have been pulled out (again). We need to get to the bottom of how and why this keeps happening.

Notice Boards

Roger Pratley has installed the additional notice board and I have moved 12 'long term' posters to it releasing lots of space on the bigger board. We now need to make sure that we keep the large board for short term notices and that they are mainly related to local events.

Toilet Sign

The simple Toilet sign above the door from the Belleme Room 'disappeared' a while ago. I have now replaced it with a new sign which has Symbols and the word Toilets.

Porch Roof

Tracey Averies has repaired the porch leak. I noted that there was quite a lot of water ingress through the doors when we had rain driving from the north recently. Paul has dried out the mat and refitted it as it had expanded a little and was rucked.

Perform

I discovered that Perform have been using the Belleme Room as a waiting room for mums while their other children have their lesson. They have not booked this room so are in breach of their agreement with us and therefore liable for an additional charge at double rate. Bill Norman is sorting it.

Projector

On several occasions recently the Projector has been moved out of alignment. This was probably by lighting engineers putting up or removing lights for the various music gigs.
